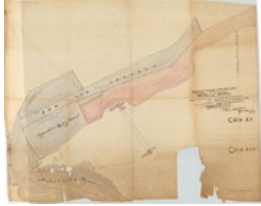

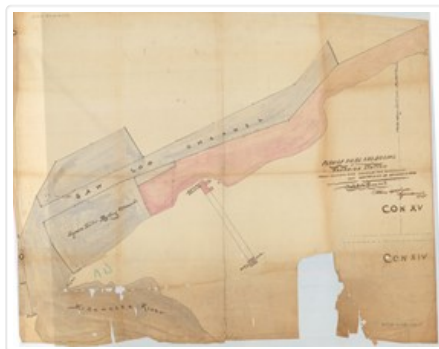


Plan of Piers & Booms of the Arnprior Station

Scope and Content:	Shows government ownership (saw log channel & square timber rafting grounds) on the Ottawa R at the mouth of the Madawaska. Shows ring bolts at the mouth and elsewhere. Shows area controlled by McLachlin Bros, including steam sawmill and sorting shed
