2. Photocopy of page 28 from "The Story of Renfrew", mentioning George Rochester and the grist mill on the Madawaska near Burnstown.

3. Handwritten notes by Archivist Anne Wimmi (1995) re references to Rochester in Phil Jenkin's book, "An Acre of Time". Rochester applied for a pension for Constant Penency [Indian].
