The Corporation of the Town of Arnprior
 Bylaw No. 6252-13
 A BYLAW TO AUTHORISE THE CLERK AND DEPUTY CLERK TO PROVIDE CIVIL MARRIAGE SERVICES
 WHEREAS the Civil Marriage Regulations (S.M. 2013, C. 10) under the Marriage Act (S.C. 1985, c. 28) authorize the Clerk of a local municipality to conduct civil marriages;
 AND WHEREAS Section 229 of the Marriage Act (S.C. 1985, c. 28) requires that municipalities participate in support of Civil Marriage Services at the pleasure and advice of the Clerk;
 AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Arnprior desires to provide civil marriage services to the public;
 NOW THE CORPORATION OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF ARNPRIOR ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:
 1. The Clerk and Deputy Clerk are hereby authorized to provide civil marriage services to the public.
 2. The fee for civil marriage services shall be as determined by the Clerk and Deputy Clerk.
 3. The fee for each service outside of regular business hours shall be One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) payable to the Corporation and One Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$150.00) payable to the Clerk for the year.
 4. The fee for attendance at the ceremony outside of regular business hours of requests shall be reported to the Clerk of the Corporation.
 5. The responsibility for administration outside of the Town of Arnprior shall be determined by the Corporation.
 6. The above have been read and approved by the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Arnprior.
